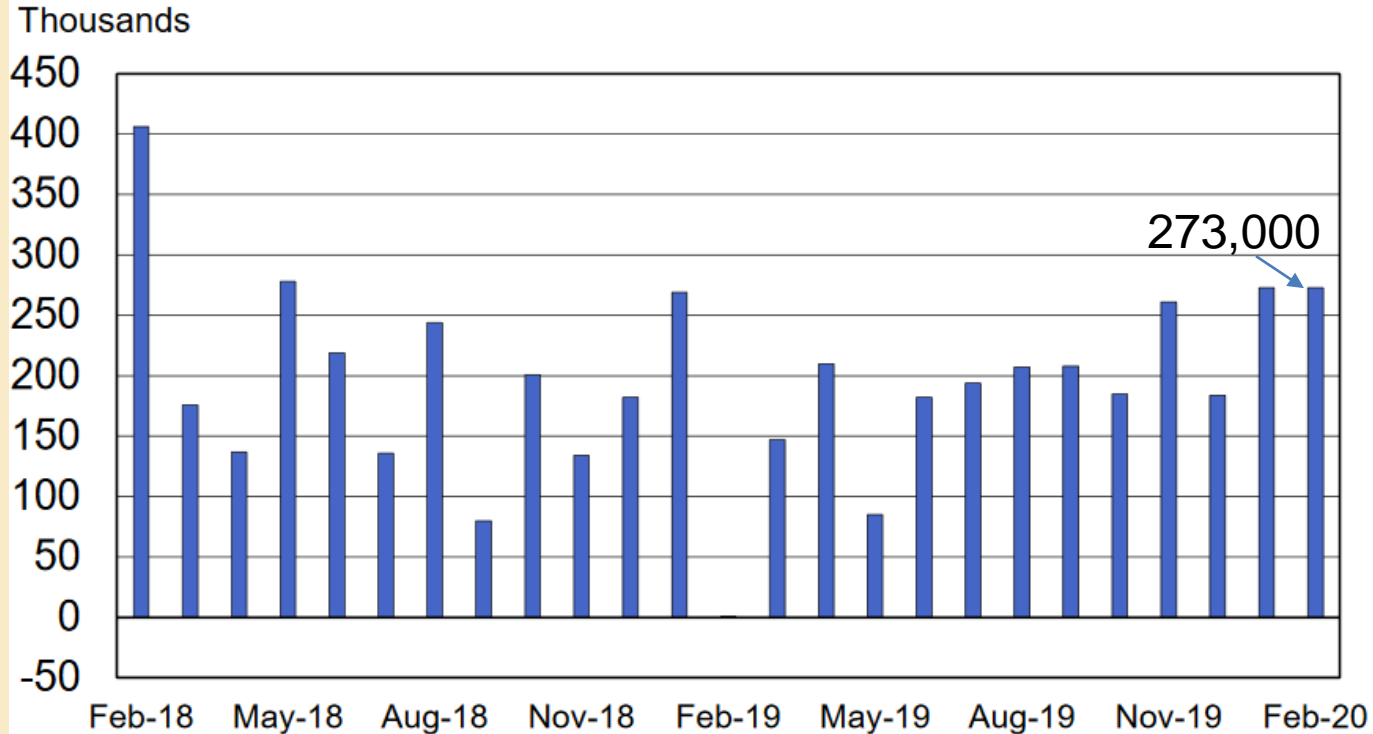




**Chart 2. Nonfarm payroll employment over-the-month change, seasonally adjusted, February 2018 – February 2020**

# 30 Year Mortgage Rate: 3.29% for Wk of Mar 05 2020

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The 30 Year Mortgage Rate is the fixed interest rate that US home-buyers would pay if they were to take out a loan lasting 30 years. There are many different kinds of mortgages that homeowners can decide on which will have varying interest rates and monthly payments. Historically, the 30-year mortgage rate reached upwards of 18.6% in 1981 and went as low as 3.3% in 2012.

30 Year Mortgage Rate is at 3.29%, compared to 3.45% last week and 4.35% last year. This is lower than the long term average of 7.98%.

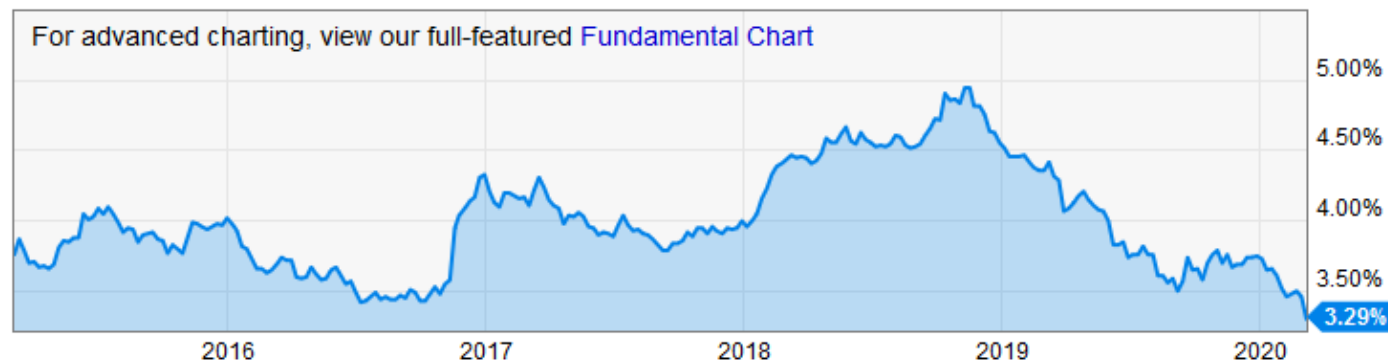
